# SURREY RUN 2025



This month I thought that I would say a little more about the Gatwick Aviation Museum where we will finish the Surrey Run on 13th July. It originally started in 1987 as a private collection by local businessman Peter Vallance. The museum became a registered charity in 1999 with the objective of providing awareness of local aviation history and as an educational centre for the general public. This was particularly relevant to local students and school children. Central Sussex College uses the museum's facilities to provide practical training for the students taking aerospace courses. Vallance died in 2013 during a heart surgery operation and since then the museum has been run by a charitable trust set up by Vallance to cover that eventuality. The museum has a variety of aircraft, aircraft engines and over 500 aircraft models. It also has on display a number of artefacts related to local aviation history particularly relevant to Gatwick Airport. The range of aircraft on display include the Avro Shackleton MR3, Blackburn Buccaneer, English Electric Lightning jet, a Percival Sea Prince and many more. On some days they actually fire up the engines.

In 2016 the new museum building first opened to the public. It houses many aircraft formerly kept outdoors. A shop, refreshment area, flight simulator and information on Gatwick Airport can also be found in the building. For the plane spotters amongst us there is a special observation point just a short walk from the MG parking area. Here you will see closeup and in real time the actual landings and take off activity at Gatwick as it happens. I am sure we will all have a great day.

# THANK YOU TO MEMBERS



Dear All members at the Epsom Area MG Owners Club,

Thank you so much for your support of Cherry Trees and for your kind donation of £400 from your annual dinner. We are so grateful to have been chosen as one of your nominated charities.

As I suspect you all know well, Cherry Trees provides home-from-home care for children with complex disabilities and a meaningful break for their families.

Last year, Cherry Trees provided more than 57,000 hours of care for 70 children from 63 families, this included 1,551 sleepovers and 633-day visits. We also organised 147 trips for the children, and provided small but vital financial grants through our welfare fund.

Every hour of care provides the family with an often much needed break, but it also supports the children as they make friends, try new activities, develop skills and independence, and build confidence they will need in later life.

Providing this lifeline costs £1.5m a year, with each hour costs approximately £25. Around two thirds of this is funded by the Local Authority, but the remaining third is raised by people and organisations in our community, by groups like Epsom MG Owners Club.

Your donation of £400, will help us provide a further 50 hours of care and support to one of our families, and ultimately reduce the chance of family breakdown. We couldn't provide this support without people like you, so thank you.

Once again thank you so much for your donation and for so kindly choosing to support Cherry Trees.
